



Morakot Meyer is an Associate Professor of History in the International Doctoral Program in Multicultural Studies at the Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia (RILCA), Mahidol University (MU), Thailand. From 2021 to 2024, she served as Director of the Institute. She also teaches in MU's International MA Program in ASEAN Studies for Sustainable Development. Her research interests include the history of diversity and migration, museums and heritage, memory, nationalism, soft power, and the cultural diplomacy and policies of ASEAN and its member states. In 2024, she edited the book "COVID Precarity and Thai Society" and contributed a chapter. She also served as the principal academic consultant for a 45-episode television documentary titled "Some One, One of Man", which promotes diversity, human rights, and inclusivity.
